Q: DO I HAVE TO TAKE AP TESTS?

WHS has elected to make AP tests optional for the 2019-2020 school year due to the Covid-19 Pandemic

Q: WHY SHOULD I STILL TAKE MY AP TESTS?

Colleges use your AP test scores to decide if they should give you college credit/placement for the AP class you took. You have worked very hard this year to prepare for the test.

Q: I HAVEN'T PAID FOR MY AP TESTS YET. CAN I STILL TAKE MY TESTS?

Yes, AP tests were ordered earlier this year; therefore, every AP student will be able to test. WHS will collect payment at a later time.

Q: WILL I STILL OWE A FEE IF I DON'T TAKE AP TESTS?

No, College Board waived fees charged for unused tests this year; therefore, students will not have to pay the exam fee if they do not test. Students that already paid their exam fees and do not test will be issued a refund in August.
