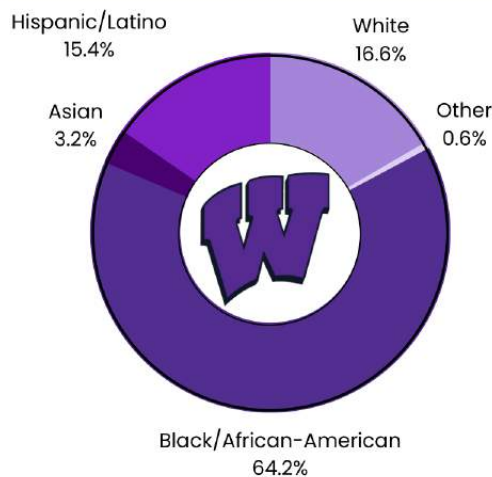
ABOUT WHS

Established in 1949, Woodlawn High School ranks among the top high schools located in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. WHS is a four-year, public high school enrolling approximately 1400 students in grades 9-12.

WHS features specialized academic and arts programs, including: Academically Gifted, Great Scholars Academy, Academic-STEM Magnet, Talented Music, Talented Theatre, and Talented Visual Arts. Students can earn early college credit through Advanced Placement (AP) courses, Dual Enrollment (DE) courses, and College Level Examination Program (CLEP) tests. Students can earn Industry-Based Certifications through completing required coursework in a career pathway and earning a qualifying score on the corresponding certification tests.
